## BUDGET REQUEST

The Board of Directors presented the Workshop's budget request to the City of Fridley at the August meeting of the Cable TV Commission. The Workshop has received grants from the City in 1979 and 1980 to meet the operational expenses. The 1982 budget request is for \$17,669. This figure will cover the coordinator's salary and benefits, and business office expenses. The City uses revenue collected from Northern Cablevision to fund the Workshop's grant requests.

The Cable TV Commission recommended the City Council approve the Workshop's request in full.

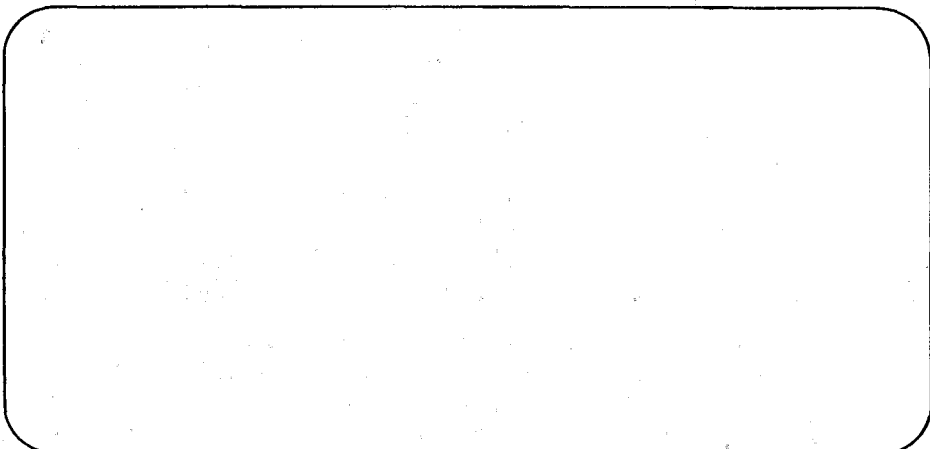
