Access Thoughts FROM THE DIRECTOR

Every day the mass media impacts our lives in numerous ways. Whether it's the morning newspaper or your favorite radio station, it seems we are constantly being barraged with messages. But who sends these messages and what tactics do they use to persuade and/or enlighten us?

There is a growing movement in access television called "Media Literacy". The concept stems from the belief that access centers can serve as not only video production educational facilities but help people to understand how the media works as well.

In the coming months I will be exploring ways we can incorporate issues concerning Media Literacy into our classes. By understanding how the media works, access producers may learn new ways in which they can communicate their ideas. And the best part is, producers can talk *from* the television instead of only letting it talk to them!

Communications With THE COORDINATOR

The past few months have been very busy here at ETC 33. We've been spending a lot of time learning the new Amilink editing system (see story below), organizing classes, producing the Willies and the Foolathon, among other endeavors.

We have also been waiting patiently for summer. But, since the weather never is quite what we want it to be, now would be the perfect time for you to sign up for a class and learn how to edit together all of that videotape which piled up over the winter.

Looking forward to summer, many of you will want to record family events and activities, and this could be a good time to brush up on those camera and Video Toaster skills. (The Workshop recently installed the new 3.1 Toaster upgrade which has -yes- even more effects! For more class info check out the next page.-Ed.)

WHAT IS AMILINK ANYWAY?

So you've probably heard by now that the Workshop has acquired two new editing systems called Amilink but you're not quite sure what that means.

Amilink is a computer based editing system that works with the Video Toaster to coordinate special effects, wipes, the character generator and other applications with the editing process.

The program is very "user friendly" and easy to learn. Once access users become familiar with the system they find that their editing is not only

easier but faster leaving more room for creativity.

With the addition of the Toaster 4000 in the studio, the edit room has been upgraded to an A/B Roll edit system. That means that now producers can integrate two source decks into the editing process. Images can be dissolved one into the other creating some exciting possibilities.

We have also added a new Macke 16 channel sound board in the edit room to accommodate the new system. These features, combined with

all new Super VHS deck, will mean a dramatic increase in picture quality for your productions. And not to worry, the new decks can still play your old regular VHS source tapes as well.

Because the system is so new, it is now necessary for anyone wishing to book edit time who is unfamiliar with Amilink to take an editing class. And for those students who wish to learn A/B roll, the Workshop offers special one-on-one instruction. Each class is only \$10.00 and includes a set of helpful handouts and tutorials.
