## HOMETOWN VIDEO AWARDS

ETC 33 has been selected to serve as a preliminary judging site for the 1995 Hometown Video Festival.

Hometown, sponsored by the Alliance for Community Media (Alliance), recognizes outstanding local cable programs that are produced by or for public, educational, and government access facilities and by local origination departments of cable systems.

Since it began in 1977, Hometown has grown dramatically, becoming local cable programming's largest video

festival. During the past five years, the Festival has received an average of 2,000 entries from 400 cities across the United States and Canada.

As a preliminary judging site, ETC 33 will judge tapes in the non-professional Music Video and Entertainment categories. This is the 6th straight year ETC 33 has served as a judging site.

The Hometown Video Festival is unique in that judging is not limited to technical quality and execution. Entries are also scored according to how they

address community concerns and the unique and creative ways in which they approach their subjects. In addition, the work of non-professionals is judged separately from the work of media professionals.

The judges from ETC 33 will select a group of four finalists in each category. Those tapes will move on to the final judging activities which will be held May 19-21 in Sacramento, California. The final awards will be given out at the Hometown Video Awards held during the Alliance for Community Media national convention held this July in Boston.

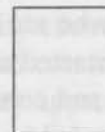
